## Contest rules:

- You may use any art materials you like (exs. crayons, paint, pastels, markers, colored pencils, collage scraps)
- Use 8 1/2 x 11 paper, held in either portrait or landscape orientation
- You may use colors or shades of white, black, and gray
- Your artwork *must* include a large numeral from 1-9 (1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8 or 9)
- Your picture must be handed in to your classroom teacher by May 24<sup>th</sup>. (If you attend school remotely, just take a photo of your finished artwork and send it to your teacher.)
- Please tape a piece of paper to the back of your artwork with your name, school name, grade, and a sentence or two telling why you chose that special number.
- Your parents may help you gather your materials, but all artwork must be completed by the student.
