Let's go on an exploration to find fish and frogs, and learn why the Pine Barrens water is such a good habitat for these creatures. Meet at the Kettle Run East Trailhead

Eco Art

We'll hike and collect unique objects from the forest floor, turn these objects into special art and take a gallery tour in the forest. Meet at the Kettle Run East Trailhead

Small Wonders and Sketching

Look very closely at objects in the forest. Using markers and pencils we'll sketch these wonders of nature. Meet at the Kettle Run East Trailhead
