Our classes are learning about him and his work in various ways this week and next week. For example, some students may engage in discussion and writing activities after exploring Dr. King Jr. digital libraries which include watching videos and listening to books.

Start of Shortened Day Schedule on January 19

In-person learning is resuming as scheduled on Tuesday, January 19. All Cohorts (A, B, AB, and R) will continue as they have been. Friendly reminder, January 19 and 20 are A days, January 21 and 22 are B days. Our 2020-21 ETSD Calendar will be updated to reflect snow days once winter is past. School start times are the same, and AM buses and bus times are the same for all students, all grades. School end times are earlier, thus PM bus times are earlier for grades 1-5 based on the shorter schedule. PM bus times are earlier for kindergarten too, though kindergarten still ends at the same time, since PM kindergarten buses are just bringing kindergarteners home. The PM buses are the same in most cases. Preschool PM buses and times are the same. Parents are encouraged to check Genesis to review their children's bus times.

Friendly reminder: Steps we can take are points of light

- Practicing social distancing, limiting close contact, wearing masks, washing hands, and monitoring for symptoms.
- Keeping our children home if they show COVID-compatible symptoms (e.g. fever, headache, sore throat, fatigue, congestion/runny nose, cough, shortness of breath).
- Joining COVID Alert NJ to reduce the spread of COVID-19 via https://covid19.nj.gov/app. The app is easy to download and use.
