The Evesham Township School District is pleased to announce the continuation of the Saturday Enrichment Club Program for students in grades kindergarten through eight. There are several exciting choices that are designed to challenge your child's creativity and problem-solving skills. A brief description of each club is included on the attached registration form. All clubs will be held on eight Saturday mornings, beginning on January 5<sup>th</sup> and ending on March 2<sup>nd</sup> (no session February 16<sup>th</sup>). There are two different time slots/sessions being offered, each of which is for one and a half hours. You may choose to register for one or both sessions. The cost of each session is \$85.00. You may sign your child up for two different clubs/sessions at a discounted rate of \$160.00 for the same child. Please note the LEGO courses offered at the elementary and middle school level are run by an outside organization, Bricks 4 Kidz, and have an additional fee of \$10 associated with them (\$95 for one session or if signing up for two sessions \$170). All programs will be held at DeMasi Middle School. Transportation **will not** be provided.

In order to accommodate your child's needs, please complete the attached registration form and return with payment to the following address as soon as possible. The deadline for registration is **December 17, 2018**. Registrations will be honored on a first come, first served basis, as space is limited. 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## CLUB DESCRIPTIONS

### Elementary Clubs

**Broadcasting** - Integrate technology and current events! Students will create and produce a weekly news program that will focus on local and national stories. Students will receive a compilation DVD of their work at the end of the eight weeks.

**Create Your Own Adventure** - Creative writing with a technology twist! Don't just write boring old stories. Write interactive stories and let your reader take control of the plotline! Your stories can be different every time you read them. This course will focus on creative writing techniques, as well as basic computer science skills in order to create truly interactive stories and animations. Using Google Slides and other online tools, you will create stories that are unlike any you have ever written before!

**LEGO Winter Fun** - Don't get left out in the cold! Bring the winter fun indoors with interactive Bricks 4 Kidz models of some popular winter activities from the hair-raising thrill of the luge to more the relaxing pace of the horse and sleigh. We'll build the all-business snowplow as well as the all-fun snow mobile. And our winter theme wouldn't be complete without ice hockey and skiing. No snow? No problem - all you need to create these winter memories are our bricks and your imagination.

**Kids in the Kitchen** - Hands-on activities to teach children about the joy of preparing and eating delicious, healthy foods. Students will focus on identifying ripe fresh fruits and vegetables, making no-bake healthy treats, like smoothies, and play hostess. As students explore the tools of the kitchen, they will identify and use age-appropriate portions sizes and make appetizing displays

**Splash on Art** - Interested in the arts? Through creativity and self-discovery, learn about art history. Explore a variety of techniques in this club such as drawing, painting, collage, and more. We will also learn about well known artists and emulate their style.

**Survival Sewing** - What happens when you lose a button or your hem falls out? Come learn how to measure and cut fabric, sew on buttons, etc. You will even get to create individualized special projects to take home at the end of our session.

## Middle School Clubs

**Every Picture Tells a Story** - In this workshop, students will tap into their creative side and work with different types of medium. Students may use digital photography, graphic illustrations, original artwork or a combination of all of these to present a story or illustrate a theme. An exhibit will culminate the workshop.

**Kids in the Kitchen** - Hands-on activities to teach children about the joy of preparing and eating delicious, healthy foods. Students will focus on identifying ripe fresh fruits and vegetables, making healthy treats that require cooking, like taco salad, or no cook foods like smoothies. As students explore the tools of the kitchen, they will identify and use age -appropriate portions sizes and use app, MyNetDiary, to track the nutritional break-down of the prepared foods.

**Journalism** - Learn the art of news writing from gathering facts to creating headlines. Techniques for interviewing a witness will also be integrated throughout. Design a Saturday Enrichment news bulletin to culminate this club.

**Splash on Art** - Interested in the Arts? Come and join the advanced study of Art History coupled with student-created pieces reflective of the style and technique of the masters. Pieces created in this club can be used as part of the portfolio for **Every Picture Tells a Story** as well.
