Dear ETSD Families,

In the event of an emergency such as extreme weather conditions or loss of utilities, the Evesham Township School District may be closed. A weather-related closing is typically announced early in the morning on the day of the closure. A message will be sent to all parents/guardians by phone and email through SchoolMessenger, the district's primary notification system. Additionally, information regarding school closings will be posted on the district website (<u>www.evesham.k12.nj.us</u>) and Facebook/Twitter, as well as other media outlets such as local TV. The district's emergency closing number is **#**657.

Our district may use a two-hour delayed opening of our schools due to inclement weather conditions or other emergencies. Delayed openings will <u>only</u> be used if students and staff can safely attend school and the forecast indicates improving conditions. For all two-hour delayed openings, please see the information and adjusted start times below. Note: There are no scheduled delayed openings.

REMINDERS FOR DELAYED OPENINGS:

- 1. All bus students should report to their bus stops two hours after their regularly scheduled time.
- 2. Lunches will be served as usual, and dismissal at all schools will be the same as usual.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR DELAYED OPENINGS:

- 1. AM Preschool Disabled classes will be cancelled.
- 2. AM Preschool Inclusion classes will attend the PM classes (transportation provided for IEP students only). No transportation will be provided for AM & PM students without IEPs.
- 3. Full Day Preschool Classes will follow the elementary schedule.
- 4. MES's AM kindergarten class will attend in the afternoon (12:19 pm 2:55 pm).
- 5. All after-school clubs and activities will be held, unless cancelled by the building principal.
- 6. AM Just Kids will be closed and PM Just Kids will run as normal.

If we need to use an emergency early dismissal (very rare), we will give as much prior notice as possible. In the event of an emergency early dismissal, we may choose to cancel all half-day AM and PM classes or allow the AM students to attend at their regularly scheduled time and cancel PM classes only. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.
